

Code of Ethics Training for Public Officers

Florida Statute 112.3142 states that all constitutional officers and elected municipal officers must complete 4 hours of ethics training annually that addresses, at a minimum, s. 8, Art. II of the State Constitution, the Code of Ethics for Public Officers, Employees, and the public records and public meetings laws of this state.

State Attorney Catherine Vogel and County Attorney Bob Shillinger will be teaching a course that meets the statutory criteria. There is no cost for the course. Your agency will not have to incur any travel expenses or tuition to meet this statutory requirement. Members of the public are invited to attend. If you have an employee (or two) that you think could benefit from attendance please forward this e-mail to them and invite them to attend.
